

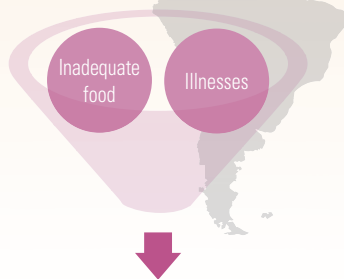
CONTEXT
